Community Outreach

The Community Policing Unit along with numerous members of the department conducted the second annual Kids Police Academy at West End School. 26 First time notices were sent out for false alarm activations and 9 warnings were sent to habitual offenders.

Narcotics Strike Force

The Narcotics Strike Force spent approximately 40 man hours in the Boro doing surveillance and gathering information on narcotic activity. In July a search warrant was obtained and executed at a residence in the Boro due to an investigation and during the execution of that warrant heroin, mushrooms, marijuana and MDMA were recovered and the suspect was arrested. Another investigation led to an arrest of a suspect with over 100 grams of marijuana recovered. In a multi-agency investigation led by Officer Kropewnicki an arrest and search warrant were obtained for a Piscataway resident and during that arrest and search warrant narcotics and weapons were recovered.
