"Personal Information" means information that identifies an individual, including an individual's photograph; social security number; driver identification number; name; address other than the five-digit zip code; telephone number; and medical or disability information, but does not include information on vehicular accidents, driving violations, and driver's status.

USES PERMITTED AS SET FORTH IN N.J.S.A. 39:2-3.4(c)

- For use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver safety and theft: motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle
 product alterations, recalls, or advisories; performance monitoring of motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts and dealers;
 motor vehicle market research activities, including survey research; and the removal of non-owner records from the
 original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers.
- 2. For use in the normal course of business by a legitimate business or its agents, employees or contractors, but only:
 - a. to verify the accuracy of personal information submitted by the individual to the business or its agents, employees, or contractors; and
 - b. if such information as so submitted is not correct or is no longer correct, to obtain the correct information, but only for the purposes of preventing fraud by, pursuing legal remedies against, or recovering on a debt of security interest against the individual.
- 3. For use in connection with any civil, criminal, administrative or arbitral proceeding in any federal, state or local court or agency or before any self-regulatory body, including service of process, investigation in anticipation of litigation, and the
 - execution or enforcement of judgments and orders, or pursuant to an order of a federal, state or local court.
- 4. For use in research activities, and for use in producing statistical reports, so long as the personal information is not published, redisclosed, or used to contact individuals.
- 5. For use by any insurer or insurance support organization, or by a self-insured entity, or its agents, employees, or contractors, in connection with claims investigation activities, antifraud activities, rating or underwriting.
