Cat Licenses

North Plainfield Revised General Ordinance 5-2.5 requires owners of cats (7 months of age or older) to license their cats annually. The cat owner must show proof that a licensed veterinarian administered a rabies vaccine to the cat (Rabies Vaccination Certificate). The Rabies Vaccination Certificate shall prove that the cat has been inoculated against rabies with a vaccine having duration of immunity which extends throughout at least 10 of the 12 months of the licensing period. Cats with duration of immunity against rabies that expires prior to the tenth (10th) month of the licensing period shall be revaccinated prior to issuance of a license.

If you have never licensed a cat in the Borough of North Plainfield, you will need to provide a valid NJ Driver's License or NJ Issued ID and the following information:
