October – Breast Cancer Awareness Month

WHEREAS, approximately 1 in 8 women and 1 in 833 men in the United States will develop invasive breast cancer over the course of their lives; and

WHEREAS, in 2023, an estimated 300,590 cases of invasive breast cancer, will be diagnosed in the US; and

WHEREAS, an estimated 43,780 people will lose their lives to metastatic breast cancer in 2023; and

WHEREAS, as of January 2022, there were over 4 million women living with a history of breast cancer in the US; and

WHEREAS, about 9 percent of all new breast cancer cases are diagnosed in women 45 and under; and

WHEREAS, although black women have a lower incidence of breast cancer than white women, black women are 40 percent more likely to die of breast cancer; and

WHEREAS, when breast cancer is detected early, it can be treated more successfully, increasing the chances for survival.

NOW THEREFORE, I, Mayor Lawrence La Ronde, on behalf of the Borough of North Plainfield, do hereby proclaim October, 2023 as Breast Cancer Awareness Month and urge everyone to learn more about the benefits of early detection and yearly screenings.
