Council President Stabile read the following Notice of Compliance:

PUBLIC COMMENT:

Daniel Battista, 34 Regent Street, North Plainfield, shared his displeasure with the lack of uniformity in the hometown hero banners on Somerset Street. Calling attention to the numerous street lamps out along Somerset Street, the speaker urged for resolution. Acknowledging his concerns, Mr. Hollod noted that PSE&G had been slow in their response to replace them.

NEW BUSINESS:

1. Approval of Change Order/Final Payment/Project Closeout of Rockview Avenue Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project for Vortex Services, LLC – D.E.H. Mr. Hollod explained that this resolution approves final payment to Vortex Services, LLC in the amount of \$12,454.75 and closes out the contract and the release of retainage for the Rockview Avenue Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project.

- 2. New Year's Eve Hours for Establishments which serve Alcohol F.S.S. Council President Stabile explained that Mr. Penaloza requested permission to sell alcoholic beverages until 5:00 a.m. on New Year's Day. No council members favored this proposal.
- 3. **Snow Removal Policy & Incentives** S. M. Mr. McIntyre shared his concerns with those residents and businesses that do not remove snow from their sidewalks after a storm. Referencing the existing ordinance, the councilman favored a review with consideration of more severe penalties for violators. Joining in, Mr. George advised of programs in which volunteers shovel sidewalks for those residents that are unable to do so themselves. It was agreed to further research the matter.
