WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has an ordinance prohibiting the sale of alcoholic beverages on January 1, New Year's Day, between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 11:00a.m.; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a written request from The Bridge, Plenary Retail Consumption License No. 1814-33-001-003, The Paradise Club, Plenary Retail Consumption License No. 1814-33-007-008 and Mi Mundo Latino, Plenary Retail Consumption No. 1814-33-008-006 to allow the extension of their hours of operation on New Year's Day, Monday, January 1, 2024 for one (1) hour to 3:00am to better enable them to serve their clientele and to improve their receipts; and,

WHEREAS, representatives of The Bridge, The Paradise Club & Sports Bar and Mi Mundo Latino appeared before the Governing Body and requested said permission to close at a later hour on New Year's Day, Monday, January 1, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough has received a written request from Herb's Liquors, Plenary Retail Distribution License No. 1814-44-012-006, and Clinton Liquors, Plenary Retail Distribution License No. 1814-44-005-009, a representative of which appeared before the Governing Body and requested permission to close at 10:00pm on Christmas Eve, Sunday, December 24, 2023, and New Year's Eve, Sunday, December 31, 2023, to better enable those establishments to serve their clientele and to improve their receipts; and,

WHEREAS, Christmas Eve and New Year's Eve generate a large amount of business for alcoholic beverage licensees in the Borough; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to grant the requests of The Bridge, The Paradise Club & Sports Bar and Mi Mundo Latino to remain open until 3:00am on January 1, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough wishes to grant the request of Herb's Liquors and Clinton Liquors, to remain open until 10:00pm on Sunday, December 24, 2023, and Sunday, December 31, 2023.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey that the business hours restriction on the sale of alcoholic beverages is hereby suspended on January 1, 2024 to allow The Bridge, The Paradise Club & Sports Bar and Mi Mundo Latino to remain open until 3:00am on January 1, 2024, subject to all other requirements thereof; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey that Herb's Liquors and Clinton Liquors shall be permitted to close at 10:00pm on Sunday, December 24, 2023, and Sunday, December 31, 2023 subject to all other requirements thereof.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-11-23-02f RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND ACTING MUNICIPAL CLERK TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE BOROUGH OF BOUND BROOK FOR THE USE OF A NEW JERSEY EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES LICENSED AMBULANCE

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield and the Borough of Bound Brook have available ambulances licensed by the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Medical Services; and,

WHEREAS, from time to time, the Borough of North Plainfield or the Borough of Bound Brook may have a need for the use of an ambulance licensed by the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Medical Services, such as, but not limited to, during fleet maintenance; and,

WHEREAS, said Agreement provides for the use of an ambulance licensed by the State of New Jersey Office of Emergency Medical Services without costs or fees to the Borough of North Plainfield and upon stated terms; and,

WHEREAS, the said Agreement provides that the parties shall maintain insurance to cover any risk, damage or injury which may occur to or because of the use of said ambulance during such time as the other party, its officials, officers or employees are using said ambulance under the Agreement and shall name the other as an additional insured.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the Mayor and the Acting Municipal Clerk or designee, on behalf of the Borough, to sign and/or execute

the Agreement received from the Borough of Bound Brook for the occasional loan or use of an ambulance licensed by the New Jersey Office of Emergency Medical Services. Said Agreement is incorporated herein by reference as if same was fully set forth, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council.

RESOLUTION NO. 12-11-23-02g RESOLUTION OF THE BOROUGH COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND DEPUTY BOROUGH CLERK OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE COUNTY OF SOMERSET, DIVISION OF TRANSPORTATION.

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield is in need of a mode and manner to provide ambulatory and accessible transportation services to North Plainfield residents; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset, Division of Transportation is authorized to provide ambulatory and accessible transportation services for the purposes of grocery shopping, chore services and recreation; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield and the County of Somerset, Division of Transportation desire to enter into a Transportation Service Agreement to provide ambulatory and accessible transportation services to North Plainfield residents; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset, Division of Transportation will provide these services via an accessible bus, provided by the Somerset County Division of Transportation. The Division of Transportation will also provide the driver, necessary driver training, vehicle maintenance, liability insurance, workers compensation, fuel and other necessary items associated with the providing of the transportation services; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield agrees to pay a cost for each day of the provided service at the rate of One Hundred Eighty Dollars and Eighty Five Cents (\$182.90) per day; and,

WHEREAS, the County of Somerset, Division of Transportation shall provide a detailed report to the Borough of North Plainfield no later than the fifteenth (15th) day of each month. The report shall include the number of users, the number of service days, the number of trips and a description of the nature of the trips taken by North Plainfield residents. With the report, the County of Somerset, Division of Transportation shall provide a voucher and invoice for the services provided. Monthly payments shall be submitted by the Borough to the County by the tenth (10th) calendar day of the following month; and,

WHEREAS, the terms of the Agreement shall run from January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield shall comply with the notice and cancellation requirements to the residents as set forth in the Agreement, which is attached hereto.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Borough Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey that the Borough Council hereby authorizes the

Mayor and the Acting Borough Clerk, on behalf of the Borough, to sign and/or execute the attached Agreement (as amended) with the Somerset County, Division of Transportation, for a period beginning January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 for ambulatory and accessible transportation services, without the need for any further action of this Borough Council.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the Borough authorized the Purchasing Agent on behalf of the Borough to issue and execute a Purchase Order for the foregoing to the above vendors with funds certified available by the Chief financial Officer; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the CFO has been authorized to arrange to pay for the foregoing in accordance with the terms of the purchase order in the amount not to exceed of \$44,000.
