AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND, REVISE AND SUPPLEMENT CHAPTER 7A OF THE BOROUGH CODE, ENTITLED "TRAFFIC SCHEDULES", MORE SPECIFICALLY CHAPTER 7A-3, ENTITLED "SCHEDULE III, PARKING PROHIBITED DURING CERTAIN HOURS," AND MOST NOTABLY SECTION 7A-3(E), ENTITLED "NO PARKING ON MONDAY BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 2:00AM AND 6:00AM", AND MOST **NOTABLY SECTION** 7A-3(K), **ENTITLED** "NO **PARKING** WEDNESDAY 7:00AM TO 5:00PM", AND MOST NOTABLY SECTION 7A-3(M), ENTITLED "NO PARKING THURSDAY 7:00AM TO 5:00PM", AND, MOST NOTABLY SECTION 7A-3(N), ENTITLED "NO PARKING FRIDAY 2:00AM TO 6:00AM,"

WHEREAS, § 7-3.5 of the Borough Code of the Borough of North Plainfield provides that no person shall park a vehicle between the hours specified in Schedule III of Chapter 7A of the Borough Code on any day (except Sundays and public holidays) upon any of the streets or parts of streets described in Schedule III of Chapter 7A of the Borough Code; and,

WHEREAS, after proper investigation, the North Plainfield Police Department has determined that parking along Dupont Street in the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset, State of New Jersey should be modified to permit parking along said street during the school hours of the Stony Brook School; and,

WHEREAS, such locations are described in Schedule III of Chapter 7A of the Borough Code; and,

WHEREAS, the Borough finds it necessary and appropriate to amend, revise and supplement Schedule III of Chapter 7A-3 of the Borough Code regarding parking prohibited during certain hours as aforesaid.

WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield has received correspondence, communications and public comment urging support of pending legislation to mandate minimum nursing staffing levels in New Jersey's hospitals; and,

WHEREAS, such information, as presented, has provided materials supporting the enactment of such legislation, including:

- 1. A one (1)-patient increase in a nurse's workload increased the likelihood of an in-patient death within thirty (30) calendar days of admission by seven (7%) percent; and,
- 2. Mortality risk decreases by nine (9%) percent for ICU patients and sixteen (16%) percent for surgery patients with the increase of one (1) FTE (fulltime) RN per patient day; and,
- 3. Nurse staffing shortages are a factor in one (1) out of every four (4) unexpected hospital deaths or injuries caused by errors; and,
- 4. A 2021 study published in the <u>American Journal of Infection Control</u> found that each additional sepsis patient per nurse was associated with nineteen (19%) percent higher odds of in-hospital mortality; and,
- 5. A study of New York hospitals in 2021 showed significant decreases in patient deaths would occur if patient care was limited to a ratio of four (4) patients to one (1) Nurse: 4,370 deaths would have been avoided in New York just among Medicare patients during the two(2)-year study; and,

WHEREAS, this staffing crisis can and will continue to have dire consequences on the delivery of care.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of North Plainfield, County of Somerset and State of New Jersey urge the New Jersey Legislature and Governor Murphy to pass and sign into law \underline{S} .304 and \underline{A} .4536, or their successor legislation in the 2024-2025 Legislative Session, to mandate safe staffing levels in every hospital.

CID Monthly Report

A Sample of Investigations & Arrests

On October 1, 2023 at 2341 hrs., patrol responded to the area of Grove Street and Prospect Place for a report of a suspicious male attempting to enter vehicles. The description was a Hispanic male wearing a white hooded sweatshirt, jeans and white sneakers. Officers stopped a suspect fitting that description. During the investigation, the victim said she found her trunk and her boyfriend's trunk open but nothing was missing. She saw the suspect standing there for several minutes before walking to Grove Street where he was stopped. It was discovered through the investigation that the suspect had two active warrants out of Paterson. He was placed under arrest and searched. During the search, the arresting officer found a crack pipe. The suspect was processed and released on recognizance on the warrants and he was issued a summons for drug paraphernalia.

On October 21, 2023 at 2204 hrs., an officer was in his marked police car traveling west on Prospect Place when he observed a black sports utility vehicle (SUV) traveling at a high rate of speed north on Washington Avenue. The vehicle took an abrupt turn east on Prospect Place and accelerated at a high rate of speed towards the patrol vehicle in the officer's lane of travel. The officer activated his emergency lights to advise the driver to stop but the driver did not brake until he was within millimeters of the patrol vehicle. The officer could clearly see the driver, who then continued east on Prospect Place ignoring the officer's commands to stop. The officer found the suspect vehicle parked in

a driveway nearby. He approached the driver and requested his license, registration, and insurance. The driver refused to provide the documents and was placed under arrest for obstruction. The suspect's wife was contacted by another officer and she provided his identity. He was issued a summons for obstruction and issued multiple motor vehicle summonses and released.

October 29, 2023 at 0205 hrs., two officers were in a stationary position in the area of Steiner place as a local establishment was closing and its patrons were letting out. They then heard six to seven shots fired coming from the area of Greenbrook Road and a row of businesses on Greenbrook Road. One officer observed a Gray Toyota Tundra driving south through a parking lot. He observed the driver of the truck look directly at him and using loud verbal commands, he ordered the driver to stop. The driver ignored the officer and fled north on Duer Street. The truck was then stopped by another officer at the intersection on Greenbrook Road near Grove Street. Back-up officers arrived and they conducted a felony stop. The driver and the passenger were taken into custody. A patrol supervisor, who was also on the scene, confirmed that there were no gunshot victims, however he did locate several shell casings in the parking lot where the shots were fired. A witness reported that a male, matching the description of one of the suspects was shooting a gun in that parking lot. A loaded Glock magazine was located underneath a red Toyota Tundra parked in front of a residence on Duer Street. CID was notified and a detective responded. The detective assisted in canvassing the area and located a 9mm semi-automatic pistol in the bushes near where the magazine was located. Both suspects were later interviewed and they gave post Miranda statements as to what occurred. One suspect admitted that he fired the gun in the air in the parking lot and was charged with first degree attempted murder and related weapons offenses. The other suspect was charged with unlawful possession of a weapon second degree. They were both lodged in the Somerset County Jail.
