WHEREAS, the Borough of North Plainfield (hereinafter referred to as the "Borough") is in need of certain utility improvements for the Contract 2023-01 Rockview Avenue Sanitary Sewer Rehabilitation Project (hereinafter referred to as the "Project"); and,

WHERESAS, the Borough solicited bids for the Project and the following three (3) bids were received:

WHEREAS, the estimate of Mott McDonald, the Borough's Engineer on the Project, was Ninety Seven Thousand One Hundred Seventy Nine Dollars and Thirty Six Cents (\$97,179.36) for the Project, indicating that the low bid of One Hundred Two Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars and No Cents (\$102,914.00), while six percent (6%) higher than the Engineer's estimate and, upon review, is still favorable to the Borough and the low bid price is reasonable overall; and,

WHEREAS, Director of Law/Borough Attorney Eric M. Bernstein, Esquire and the offices of Eric M. Bernstein & Associates, L.L.C., as well as Mott McDonald, the Borough's Engineer on the Project, have reviewed the bid submissions and recommend the award of the bid and contract for the Project to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder, Vortex Services, L.L.C., whose main offices are located at 210 Bennett Road, Freehold, New Jersey 07728 (hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor") as there are no material defects with the bid proposal; and,
