North Plainfield Family Health & Safety Day

Pre-register for Lab Testing by Oct. 15

NORTH PLAINFIELD – The Somerset County Department of Health will sponsor the annual North Plainfield Family Health & Safety Day on Saturday, Oct. 16. The event will be held from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m. at the North Plainfield Senior Citizen / Community Center, located on the corner of Greenbrook Road and Clinton Avenue.

A comprehensive wellness blood screening is being offered. The screening includes a blood test for a complete blood count (CBC) and liver, kidney and lipid profiles. Fasting is required, which means that participants cannot eat or drink for 12 hours before the blood test.

There is a \$20 blood-analysis charge for North Plainfield residents and a \$30 charge for non-residents. **Pre-registration is requested for blood work**. Contact the Somerset County Department of Health at (908) 231-7155 by **Friday, Oct. 15**, to register.

Free pneumonia vaccinations will be offered from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m.

Seasonal flu vaccinations also will be given from 10 a.m. to 12 p.m. The fee for North Plainfield residents is \$5 and \$10 for non-residents. The vaccinations are free to seniors with Medicare Part B. Proof of enrollment in the program is required.

Representatives from the Central New Jersey Childhood Lead Poisoning Prevention Coalition will offer free testing of consumer products, including toys and cosmetics, for lead, mercury and cadmium, from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m.
