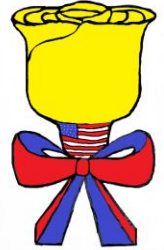

Your donation of an American flag includes a durable flag pole with a 3' X 5' 100% nylon embroidered flag, the engraving of the honoree's name on the pole, and a ground socket. The name of the honoree(s) and the donor's name will be placed in our registry book. Simply fill out this form and mail it in with a \$100.00 check.

The *Avenue of Flags* will begin on Wilson Avenue and continue around to Grove Street. The dates for the display include but are not limited to Constitution Day, Patriots Day/September 11, Veterans Day, and Flag Day; displays are subject to weather conditions. This project is part of our district's 10th anniversary of 9/11 project that is currently running through June 2012. Every effort will be made to continue such projects beyond that time.
